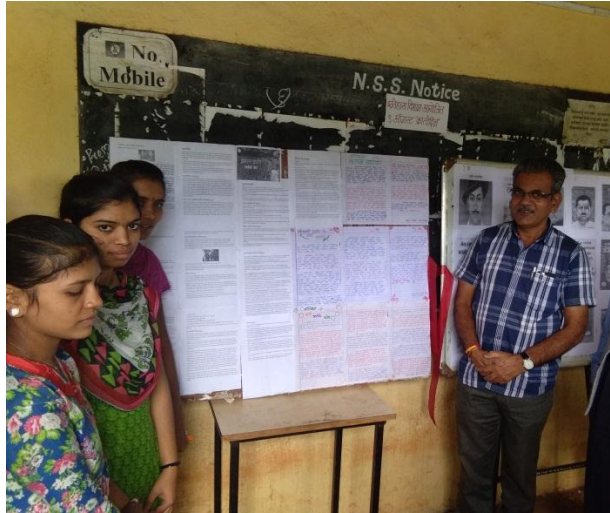
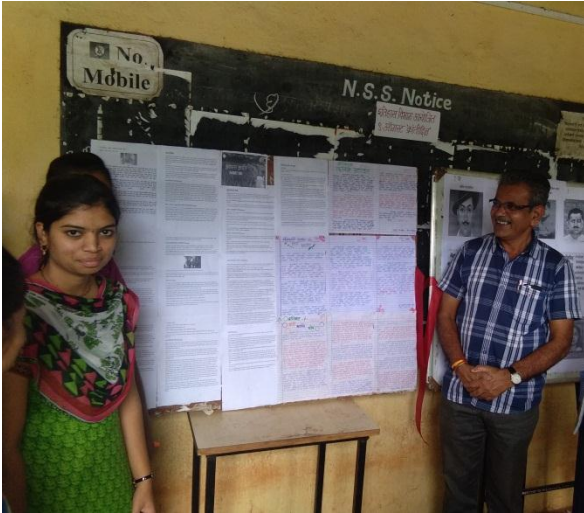

Death Anniversary of Chatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj

Sambhajiraje Bhosale (14 May 1657 – 11 March 1689) was the second ruler of the Maratha kingdom. He was the eldest son of Shivaji, the founder of the Maratha Empire and his first wife Saibai. He was successor of the realm after his father's death, and ruled it for nine years. Sambhaji's rule was largely shaped by the ongoing wars between the Maratha kingdom and Mughal Empire as well as other neighboring powers such as the Siddis, Mysore and the Portuguese in Goa. In 1689, Sambhaji was captured, tortured and executed by the Mughals, and succeeded by his brother. Sambhaji was sophisticated, educated and well-versed in a few languages other than Marathi. Sambhajiraje familiar with the famous works of different sciences and music written by ancient scholars in the Sanskrit language.

The 1687 Battle of Wai saw the Maratha forces badly weakened by the Mughals. The key Maratha commander Hambirao Mohite was killed and troops began to desert the Maratha armies. Sambhaji's positions were spied upon by his own relations, the Shirke family, who had defected to the Mughals. Sambhaji and 25 of his advisors were captured by the Mughal forces of Muqarrab Khan in a skirmish at Sangameshwar in February 1689.

In our college, we remembered the great work of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj by worshipping his photo on 11th March 2018. Principal Dr. N.K.Shinde , Joint secretary Shri J. G. Shinde , all teaching and non teaching staff and students were present for this activity. Dr. S. A. Ch.Shahu Maharaj Jayanti Report

Shahu (also known as Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj or Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj) 26 June 1874 – 6 May 1922 of the Bhosale dynasty of Marathas was a Raja (reign. 1894 – 1900) and the first Maharaja (1900-1922) of the Indian princely state of Kolhapur.

Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj, also known as Rajarshi Shahu was considered a true democrat and social reformer. Greatly influenced by the contributions of social reformer Jyotiba Phule, Shahu Maharaj was an able ruler who was associated with many progressive policies during his rule. From his coronation in 1894 till his demise in 1922, he worked for the cause of the lower caste subjects in his state. Primary education to all regardless of caste and creed was one of his most significant priorities

He also worked towards betterment of the condition of women in his empire. He established schools to educate women, and also spoke vociferously on the topic of women's education. He introduced a law banning the devadasi Pratha, the practice of offering girls to God, which essentially led to sexual exploitation of girls at the hands of the clergy. He legalized widow remarriage in 1917 and made efforts towards stopping child marriage.

Shahu introduced a number of projects which enabled his subjects to sustain themselves in their chosen professions. The Shahu Chhatrapati Spinning and Weaving Mill, dedicated marketplaces and co-operative societies for farmers were established to free his subjects from predacious middlemen in trading. He made credits available to farmers looking to buy equipment to modernize agricultural practices, and even established the King Edward Agricultural Institute to instruct farmers in increasing crop yield and related techniques. He initiated the Radhanagari Dam on 18 February 1907; the project was completed in 1935 and made Kolhapur self-sufficient in water. He was a great patron of art and culture, encouraging music and the fine arts. He supported writers and researchers in their endeavors. He installed gymnasiums and wrestling pitches and highlighted the importance of health consciousness among the youth.

In order to that History department of our college celebrated Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Jayanti every year on 26th June. Principal Dr. N.K.Shinde and Joint secretary Shri J.G. Shinde honored Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj by Photo puja . Dr. S. A. More Head Department of History addressed to all staff and students regarding the great work of Chhatrapati Shahu maharaj. National Science Day is celebrated on 28th February every year. It is celebrated to commemorate the discovery of the Raman Effect by Indian physicist Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman on 28 February 1928. On this day in 1928, he discovered a phenomenon of scattering of photons which was later known as 'Raman Effect' after his name. After two years in 1930, he got Nobel Prize for this remarkable discovery and this was the first Nobel Prize for India in the field of Science. To mark the discovery of his famous phenomenon National Science Day is celebrated in India on the day each year. In 1986, the National Council for Science and Technology Communication (NCSTC) asked the Government of India to designate 28 February as National Science Day which the then Govt. of India accepted and declared the day as National Science Day in 1986. The first National Science Day was celebrated on February 28, 1987. The theme for the National Science Day 2018 is "Science for Nation Building". The basic objective of observation of National Science Day is to spread the message of importance of science and its application among the people.

In our college we celebrated National Science Day by science models and posters exhibitions prepared by students. Students were given various subject regarding environment pollution, global warming, ozone depletion, green chemistry, wetlands and their economic importance.


